



## POLICE INVOLVED SHOOTING FACT SHEET

**July 21, 2016**

- Monday, July 18, 2016, North Miami Police Officers were dispatched to a 911 call near the area of North East 127 Street and 14th Ave.
- A White Hispanic Male (W/H/M) wearing gray and black pants threatening to commit suicide and that he had a gun pointed at his head.
- Officers responded and quickly attempted to negotiate with the W/H/M.
- Police Officers made contact with two individuals.
- Mr. Charles Kinsey, later identified as an employee from a nearby group home, was shot by one of our Officers. Mr. Kinsey was transported to the hospital with non-life threatening injuries.
- Per Departmental policy, the officer involved in the shooting has been placed on administrative leave.
- Pending the outcome of the investigation, we are not at liberty to release any information regarding the investigation pursuant to [Florida Statutes 112.533](#).
- The Officer involved in the shooting is a 30 year-old Hispanic Male and has been with the North Miami Police Department for 4 years.
- The Chief of Police has requested that the Florida Department of Law Enforcement conduct the investigation. The Department is also working closely with the Miami Dade State Attorney's Office.
- State law prohibits us from discussing the details of an open internal investigation.

## UPDATE

July 22, 2016

- The Officer involved in the shooting has now been identified as Jonathon Aledda.
- Commander Emile Hollant has been placed on Administrative Leave without pay, after evidence of conflicting statements given to the investigators on this specific case.
- Commander Emile Hollant is 53 years old and has been with the North Miami Police Department since 2000.
